CHARGING INSTRUCTIONS

- Before using the light for the first time, the battery must be fully charged
- The red charging indicator lights up during charging
- The green charging indicator lights up when charging is complete
- Recharge frequently

BATTERY TIPS

- The battery is not replaceable; do not leave the battery without charge for an extended period – deep discharge risks damaging the battery
- The light source of this lamp is not replaceable; when the light source reaches its end of life the whole light must be replaced

OPERATION

For 71446:

- Press the button on the top left to activate the light
- Press and hold to adjust the brightness for front light source

For 71448 & 71450:

- Press “FLASH LIGHT” button for torch
- Press main button for front light source, press and hold to adjust the brightness
- Press any button or press and hold the main button when light shuts off to activate the battery capacity indicator
- Cover the ODS (Obstruction Detection Sensor) to test the light turning off function (for model 71450 only)

Leave the function for 5 seconds to activate the brightness memory

WARNING



Read carefully and understand all instructions before operating.

- Avoid looking directly into the beam of light, as this will result in dazzling
- Do not use the lamp near a naked flame

WARRANTY STATEMENT
