50W LITHIUM ION SOLDERING IRON KIT INSTALLATION & OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS



FEATURES

This is the latest in soldering iron technology. Powered by a rechargeable lithium battery, this unit delivers a 50W output suitable for automotive / industrial applications.

New Fast Heat Technology is ready to use within 10 seconds. The unit has a 40-minute continuous runtime and is rechargeable via micro USB.

Please be aware this soldering iron heats up very quickly, 10 seconds.

CHARGING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the supplied cable, insert the micro USB connector into the end of the soldering iron, and the USB connector to a wall charger (not included) or USB socket.

The unit will take approximately 3.5 hours to fully charge. Once fully charged, the indicator light will turn from red to green.

SOLDERING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Thoroughly clean and remove other contaminants from the parts to be soldered.
- 2. Slide the soldering iron switch to the ON position. Press and HOLD the power button, the LED will illuminate indicating that the unit is turned on and heating.
- 3. Allow the tip to reach working temperature (10 seconds). Tin the tip by applying a small amount of solder to the tapered surface of tip. Remove excess solder from tip with the provided brass tip cleaner.
- 4. Tin the wires to be soldered together by heating the bare wire and allowing a small amount of solder to flow onto it ensuring the wire is completely covered in solder.
- 5. Place the two wires together and touch the tapered surface of the tip (not the point) onto the wires. Heat the wires and allow the solder to melt them together.
- 6. To ensure a strong solder join, do not touch or move the join until it has cooled completely.

HOW TO REPLACE THE TIP

- 1. Ensure soldering iron switch is in the OFF position. Allow tip to cool completely before touching or trying to replace the tip.
- 2. Use only genuine replacement tips (P/N 56395-E).
- 3. Unscrew the old tip by rotating the translucent locking nut in an anti-clockwise direction. The tip should then be able to be removed by sliding it forward.
- To install the new tip, align the keyway on the replacement tip and push it into position. Screw the rotating translucent locking nut in a clockwise direction until it locks in place.
- 5. Never file a soldering tip. Filing it will remove the protective layer, allowing the metal underneath to be eaten away by solder, resulting in permanent damage.

ADJUST THE DIRECTION OF THE TIP

Rotate the black knurled nut to adjust the direction of the tip.

WARNINGS
