
MODEL 43 COMBINATION LAMPS




INSTALLATION OF LAMP HOUSING

- Determine if you are fitting housing to L/H or R/H side of the vehicle, refer to drawings below for correct orientation of housing and cable exit position before drilling.
- Drill a Ø 10mm hole to suit the cable exit (excluding connectors).
- Drill 4 x Ø 6mm pilot holes to suit screw/rivet installation or 2 x Ø 8mm pilot holes for bolt installation depending on the application.
- Install screws/rivets or bolts and secure lamp housing to vehicle

LH Assembly




RH Assembly




SNAP LAMPS INTO BASE

- Place the bottom of the lamp into the housing, ensure the lamp is positioned so the word 'TOP' located on the lamp is facing towards the top of the housing.
- Push top of lamp inward until it 'snaps' into place.



SNAP REFLECTORS INTO BASE

- Reflectors are to be mounted at each end of the housing over mounting points.
- Insert reflector with mounting tabs facing the centre of the housing
- Once tabs are in position, push firmly and evenly on both sides of the reflector and snap firmly into housing.




WIRING INSTRUCTIONS

White: Earth (-) Red: Stop (+)


Brown: Tail (+) Green: Indicator (+)
Black: Reverse (+) Yellow: Indicator (+)

LAMP REMOVAL

 To remove lamp, insert a flat device (e.g. screw driver) between lamp and housing as marked on lamp.
 Carefully pivot device upwards until the lamp releases from the base.



 To remove reflector pull upwards on the lip located on the outer edge of the reflector.
