MOUNTING SURFACE

Lamp must be mounted on a flat surface.

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

This lamp is engineered for the cable to be placed in the specifically designed channel and to be run on the outside of the hull to avoid drilling a hole.


It is not recommended to drill a hole through the hull to feed the cable through. This is a potential entry point for water. All holes should be sealed correctly.

To fix the lamp to the hull, use a suitable marine grade adhesive.

Electrical Installation - Please consult a professional for electrical termination.

When drilling pilot holes in any type of material, it is recommended to be cautious and begin with a smaller screw. Use a centre punch for the mounting screws. If the torque required feels excessive, back the screw out and make a slightly larger hole.



1. Determine where the light/lights will be placed.
2. Pre-mark the location on where the lamp is to be fitted
3. Apply adhesive (as per the adhesive's instructions) and affix the lamp to the desired mounting location.
4. For marine and waterproof applications, further seal around the lamp using marine grade sealant.
5. Secure the lamp using the small screws provided.


